Melody on what they do in Cameroon ...

"We work with 10 languages which had never been written down. We have helped figure out alphabets for each of those languages, are helping the Cameroonians create reading materials, and have begun Bible translation in two of those languages. The men who are doing Bible translation with my husband are godly men who are called to bring God's word to their own people."

Melody on the best part of ministering in Cameroon ...

"The best part of working in Cameroon is the people. We have come to love them, and we miss them when we are away."

Melody on what life is like in Cameroon ...

"Life in the village is pretty basic for people. They don't have access to good running water, and so far there is no electricity in most of the 10 villages where we work. People live in houses made of mud bricks. They survive by farming mostly (or fishing). The children go to school if their parents pay the fees and buy them a uniform. The teachers don't have many resources (no maps on the walls, no pictures to illustrate what they are learning). There are usually three or four children to a desk, and over 100 children in each class in the primary grades. Many kids will stop school after finishing Grade 6. Those who do not go far in school help their mothers on the farms. They leave about 7:30 a.m., walk from 2 to 8 km. to their fields, work all day, and then walk home again."

"In the area where we live, there is a lot of sickness. Malaria is rampant because the area is swampy and mosquitoes are most everywhere. They also struggle with TB, typhoid, and river blindness. AIDS is a big killer where we are."

Melody on finances ...

"CBM missionaries must raise their own support, meaning that their salary is the money that people send in to the mission. In our case, we use our money to pay for our living expenses, our kids' school and hostel fees, the salaries of our translators, to help the literacy workers from time to time, and to help people who come to us with medical or food needs. Our neighbors are orphans and so we help with their day-to-day needs and their school fees. If your church ever wanted to help us specifically, you could let us know, and we might be able to suggest a project that you could work towards."
