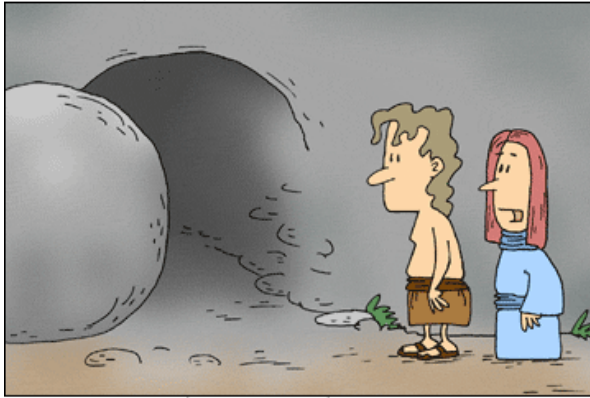

Patrick reflecting on the last year of ministry ...

"Looking back, I realize how wonderfully God has blessed His church. The four different church plantings all faced big challenges, but the blessings largely outnumbered the difficulties. One of them, after only one year of existence, could buy its own building (only for a hundred thousand dollars). This church plant added to its ministries the support group ministry 'A Tes Côtés'.

The two African church plants are facing tremendous challenges as most of their people are refugees with few or no resources. Their pastors and families are paying high financial sacrifices to serve God.

On my office door is a sticker encouraging the reader to dream big dreams. I have shared several times my dreams of seeing churches working together in reaching out in downtown Montreal. Dreams have become reality! In February, we had the first of several meetings with different churches, together with a missionary couple who will in September join our efforts in reaching out to the different religious groups, especially the Muslims - and our common dream about a 'Mathieu House' seems to be a real possibility. There is still a lot of work to do, but God loves the world, and He is in charge!"

Ria reflecting on the last year of ministry ...

"Many women received God's consolation while attending a support group. Myself, I am leading now four groups in Quebec. The first group in New Brunswick started a few months ago and is functioning well. Last autumn, in Belgium, my team and I were able to train more than 20 future facilitators. We also discussed the possibility of offering several conferences a year to the Belgian churches to train them on how to reach out in a better way to those who suffer. As the work is growing, so does the demand for more material. I am once more translating a workbook. I see God's grace in the fact that during our difficult time due to Jeremie's health problems, I was in the middle of translating a book for those who are discouraged or depressed. I was the first one to benefit from this material. God surely knows how to meet our needs!"
