"Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labour on what does not satisfy?" (Isaiah 55:2a) "Yesterday morning my field leader, Matthew Skirton, led a devotional as part of our orientation for the first short-term mission team of the summer. He used the above verse as part of his testimony of how God challenged him to consider how he would spend his life. Instead of pursuing the status quo or a comfortable life in England, Matthew and his wife, Helen, were obedient to God's call into missions. As a result they began the work of Operation Mobilization here in Moldova about 14 years ago. God has used this wonderful couple to build an amazing ministry, which serves always in partnership with the national church and has borne lasting fruit in many lives and communities. As I approach the end of my commitment with OM, I am reflecting on how I have spent my time here. I am also praying for direction on how to spend the next years of my life for the glory of God. Please pray with me that each of us who seeks to follow Jesus will not be wasting resources God has given us – spending money on what is not bread – but will invest our lives, our possessions, our energy, and our time for the true Bread of Heaven, seeking the Kingdom of God and His righteousness.



While visiting one of our outreach teams, I met Sister Dunia. I had heard of her before from Stefanie, who once served in her village. Sister Dunia is an elderly lady who lives alone in the village of Nisporeni. She has trouble walking and has very much appreciated the help of some of our outreach teams in planting her garden and other practical assistance. Stefanie one time was complaining a bit about the difficulty of living in the village. One day she saw Sister Dunia coming to church and asked her how long it had taken her to walk there. She had walked for two hours to get to church. Her comment was, 'Well, I think to myself, if sister Stefanie can come all the way from Holland to help us in Moldova, then surely I can walk a couple of hours to church to thank God for sending her and the others!' Stefanie was amazed and humbled and said she would not complain again."
