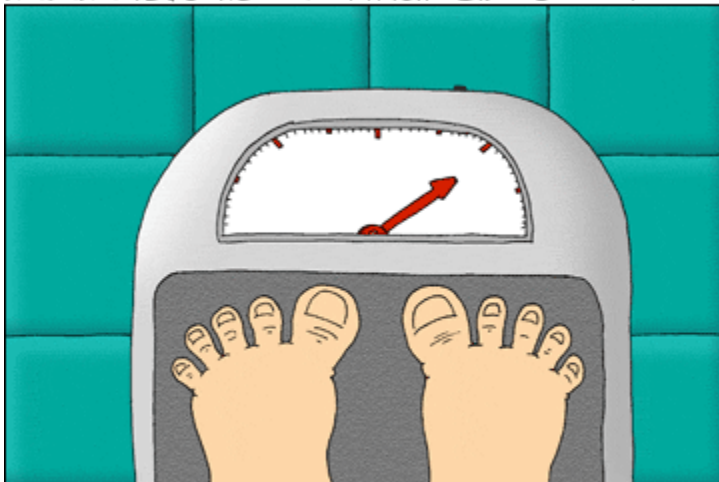

"We want to take this opportunity to present some small projects to anyone that would be interested in coming out for a day or two to help with some work. If you are able and interested, please call us.

- ✓ Re-frame two doorways and repair a third in the two-story house to seal them off for the winter months.
- ✓ Frame the inside of our cinder block garage so it can be insulated. Then board up and paint the walls.
- ✓ Help us plan the front yard of the new building. The basic dirt removal needs to happen in September, and we need a basic plan in place so we won't have to do the job twice.
- ✓ Perform small electrical jobs such as installing ceiling fans and wiring for some light fixtures.

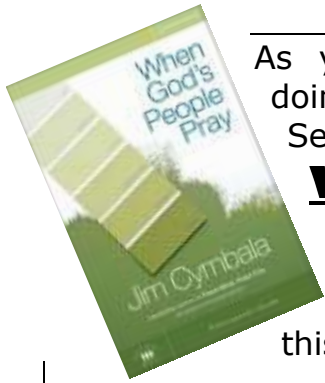
