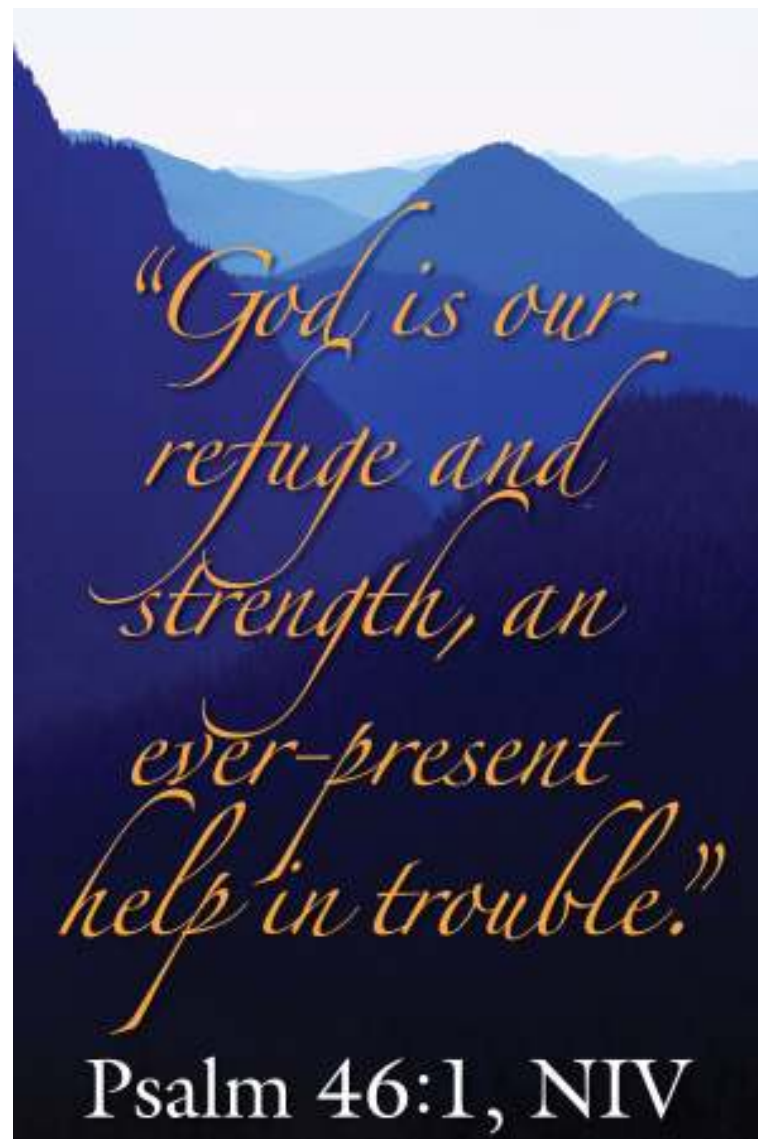

When I admire the abundance of colours, the different shapes of the trees, the flowers fluttering and dancing in the gentle breeze, and even the beauty of the many weeds, I can't help but believe in You, the great Artist, the creative and intelligent Creator and the One who loves abundance. Summer is a perfect time to celebrate You!

About two years ago, I (Patrick) met Denise and Christian L. for the first time. For a certain time already, this couple had been dreaming about planting a church in Drummondville, a city between Montreal and Quebec City. Their enthusiasm was contagious; and in no time, several other couples were willing to move and to jump into the water with them. Let me count some of the ingredients of their ministry: huge financial sacrifice, hard work, a creative outreach, a blooming support group's ministry, a real compassion for those who suffer, a strong conviction that Jesus is the answer, and big expectations of what God was going to accomplish through them. This autumn, a new missionary couple, Butch and Nell (we have been working with them in Belgium) will start to assist us in reaching out to different ethnic groups, especially the Muslims in the city of Montreal. Another dream is becoming a reality.

Next week, Patrick will start the first tests to see if he can become a donor for our son, Jérémie. It is his dearest dream to give a kidney to his son. As a parent, it is a rather difficult experience to see your child suffer! Through all this, the suffering of God our heavenly Father, seeing His children suffer in the darkness, has become a bit more real to us, as well as His motivation when He decided to send His only Son."

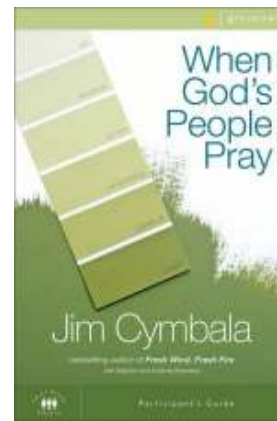
❖ Pastor Joell's Wednesday Morning CARE Group will meet September 8 at 9:30 a.m. at the church (but will not start the prayer study until September 15).
