Rebecca Alward,
CBM Missionary in Bolivia



Rebecca on how she got involved with missions...

"In my second year working at Atlantic Baptist University, I started helping with the cross-cultural internship program. The following summer, I ended up going to Albania for 10 weeks with the interns to help them settle and meet with the CBM missionaries there. It changed my life. I couldn't stop thinking about Albania, the people, and missions. So I waited six months or so and had various people close to me praying about whether I should seriously consider going into missions. My passion for it didn't waver within those months so I contacted CBM regarding the possibility of long-term missions. I spent about two years in Albania."

Rebecca on what she loves about working in Bolivia ...

"I love all the contrasts ... everything from the countryside (it's like multiple countries within one), the different people groups and languages, the strong cultural presence. Even though Bolivia is no doubt becoming more modern, there's a whole other cultural/old world presence here. Specifically as far as my work, I love the passion for God that the juvenes (ages 18 to 30) have. It's so different from the apathy that is so prevalent in Canada and North America. It's not that they're perfect or anything, but the impact that they can have (and I think will have) in the Church and missions is huge. And I actually get to be a part of that! I think for me, the biggest joy is in the relationships."

Rebecca on what she misses from home ...

"It's the people I miss most from home ... family and friends. Sometimes I struggle with thinking that I'm missing out on too much or not helping enough with family stuff; but at the same time, I can't imagine not being here, not being a part of this. I also fully admit that I miss Tim's coffee and Starbucks. As well, now that I've put in my first full year in Bolivia, I love this climate but I do miss the actual seasons in Canada with something different in them all."

Rebecca on how we can help ...

"As far as helping me (and others) ... prayer is the most important part. This work is truly impossible without you all. I don't want that to sound trite. It's the truth. I can also say that financial help is huge, especially thinking of the economic problems throughout the world and how CBM has been affected, but I also know churches are hurting as well. Things like reading blogs and ministry updates from myself and other missionaries is a way to walk with us through this and know what's going on."
