My dad was not there for me during my childhood because of his addictions. Due to abuse, my mom, brother and I moved into a transition house. My mom did marry another man, but things did not work out and they divorced. In high school, I joined the football team and looked for acceptance in all the wrong places. I was the first person in my family to graduate high school, but my life was spiraling out of control because of my addiction to alcohol and marijuana. I made the decision to go to hair school, but I was battling my addiction along with a severe gambling problem. This caused me to steal from family members and friends. My problem continued to escalate. I got in trouble with the law and was arrested a few times. In May of 2009, I tried to kill myself. I knew at this point I needed help so I checked myself into the hospital. While there, my mother told me about Teen Challenge. Since entering the program, my life has changed drastically. I wake up every morning with a smile. I know God loves me and I have a great relationship with Him. I am also able to love myself and I have restored my broken relationship with my family!
