Joyce on what brought her to missions work in Brazil ...

"Ever since I was a young child, I wanted to be a missionary. I think part of it was the fact that I thought this was a good thing to do to serve God, and probably some of my curiosity about different places added to the desire. Mostly, I was influenced by other missionaries who I met and admired. I felt called to Brazil while I was still working at First Baptist, Dartmouth. One day, I was reading a small article in CBM's Enterprise magazine about a possible work with 'street kids' in Brazil. Even though I knew nothing about street kids or drug use, God very clearly said to me, 'This is for you'. As we humans tend to do, I said to God, unbelievably, 'This?', and God said 'yes'. Since God always knows best, even though times often have been extremely difficult here in Brazil, I wouldn't change it for anything. I have been here 17 years and will stay as long as God has a mission for me here."

Joyce on the best part of ministering in Brazil ...

"The best part of working in ministry here is seeing people's lives change. Some people don't take opportunities. They seem to prefer to carry on as always, even though life doesn't offer much. Others grasp onto the hope and opportunities and go forward. As they go forward, many turn their lives over to Jesus. Our prevention work, Free Flight, is based on the model of Jesus, who reached out to help all with whom he had contact. We strive to help improve people's lives in Jesus' name."

Joyce on the hardest part of ministering in Brazil ...

"The worst part of working in Brazil is that people by nature, always try to take advantage of your help or generosity and always consider what you give to them to be something they earned in some way. That way, they don't feel indebted to anyone. It is difficult to express God's undeserved love to a people who think they have earned everything. However, we keep trying and let God do the convicting!!"

Joyce on the best way we can help ...

"We would appreciate prayer from your church and others. If anyone is interested in helping financially, we have a fund at CBM marked 'Free Flight, Brazil'. We can always use help in finishing our construction goals and in paying staff. We are trying to find more ways in which we as an Association can raise our own support. We have tried a few things, but we are still far from self-sufficiency."
