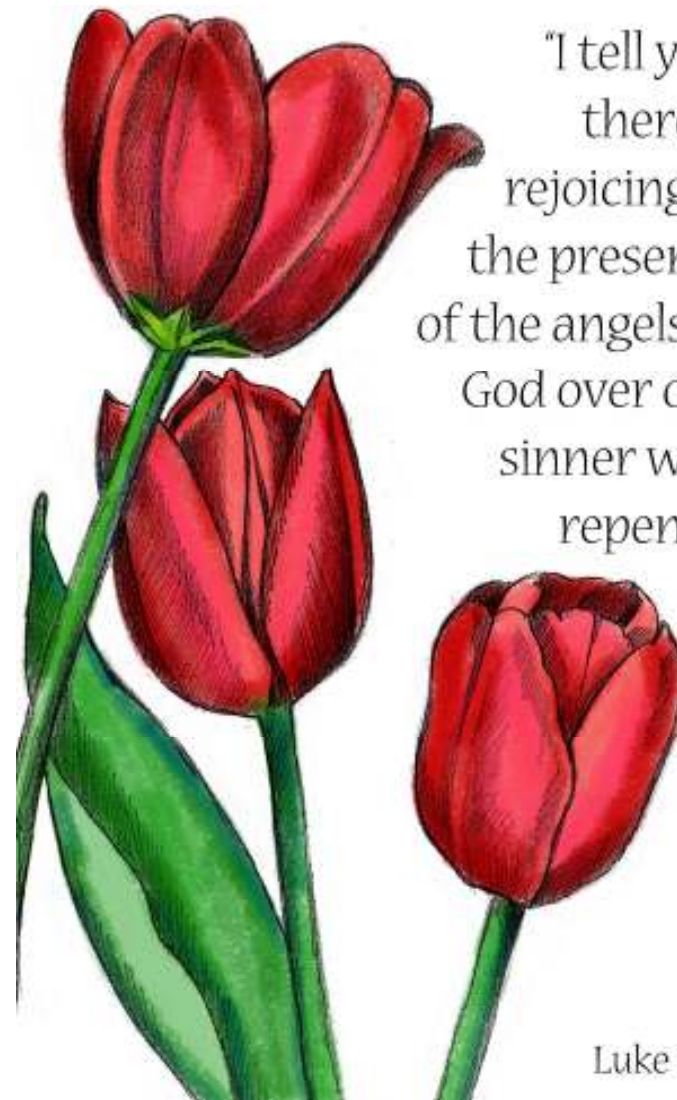

Meet our new student, Tyler:

**THANK YOU FOR YOUR SPONSORSHIP**  
Tyler M.  
I was born 3 months premature, weighing only 2 lbs. 4 ounces. I'm lucky to be alive. We were poor while I was growing up. I struggled in school and was made fun of by the other kids. After tests, it turned out I was dyslexic and had other learning disabilities. In middle school, I was a big boy and started to fight with kids who picked on me. I learned that if someone fears you, they don't make fun of you. Alcohol had always been in our home, and by the age of 13, I started to drink. Soon after, I was smoking marijuana. In grade 9, I began to hang around with an older crowd. Instead of going to school, I would spend my time with them, drinking and smoking pot. After a bad fight with my parents, I took off and moved to another city. At 15, I discovered crack cocaine. This drug would take over my life for the next 10 years. I lost everything because of it – the woman I loved, my job and home. I landed up living on the streets in a tent. I completed a 38-day rehab program and moved to another city, but my addiction followed me. Now, not only was I using again, but living in a crack house and selling. It was at this point, God began to work in my life. Through a girl I met, who is now my fiancée, I came to know Jesus Christ. She and her parents also helped me enter Teen Challenge, where I'm starting a new life. I now want my "light to shine before men" like it says in Matthew 5:16.

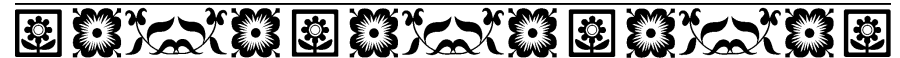
