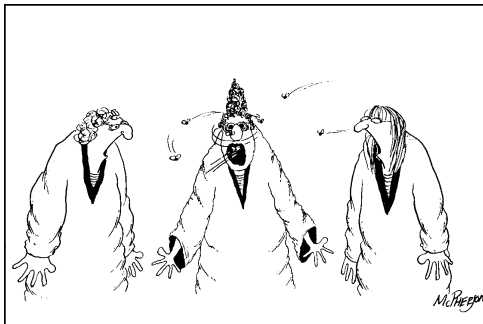

"The best part of ministering in Germany is seeing young people coming to Christ, their broken lives being fixed by the Lord one piece at a time. We feel that by the grace of God, we have somehow made a difference in their lives!"

John & Ruth on the hardest part of ministering in Germany ...

"The hardest part is leaving our aging parents and family back in Toronto."

John & Ruth on what life is like in Germany ...

"Germany is an advanced industrial nation of around 85 million people. It is not an immigrant country like Canada so it is much less ethnically diverse. German people are very formal, preferring to call each other "Herr" (Mr.) or "Frau" (Mrs./Miss/Ms.) except for the closest friends and family. They eat a lot of sausages, potatoes, and of course, sauerkraut. The weather is usually warmer than Canada. However, this past winter (not yet past for us!) is the coldest in 15 years, with lots of snow. Many brothers and sisters blame us for bringing the Canadian winter to Germany. Ha ha.

We miss the variety of food in Toronto, especially authentic Chinese food! We also missed the hockey games, although John did stay up to watch the entire Olympic Gold Medal game. GO Canada! Sydney Crosby is #1!!!"

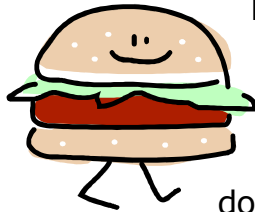
John & Ruth on how we can help serve missionaries like themselves ...
