**Deann on the best part of ministering in the Czech Republic ...**

*"The best part of ministering here is the contacts we have made throughout all of Europe. Our ministry is not only in the Czech Republic but all encompassing."*

**Deann on the hardest part of ministering in the Czech ...**

*"The hardest part would be the lack of team, as we are the only CBM missionaries here, with a lot of work to do."*

*"Of course we miss family the most. Not being able to drop in for a weekend visit and not having the children get to know their grandparents are big sacrifices. We also miss the friendliness of Canadians."*

**Deann on what life is like in the Czech Republic ...**

*"Our oldest son has been here more than half of his life now; and we adopted our youngest son, Matthew, when he was 15 months old. Life here is much like life in any big city. If you enjoy the arts, there is an abundance of concerts, operas, etc. Prague is one of the top ten tourist destinations in Europe, and is a beautiful city as it was not bombed during the wars. Food is similar to Canada – 'meat and potatoes' meals. Their traditional food is goulash and dumplings. Weather and climate are similar to your area – same seasons. Sometimes winters are very cold, but we often do not have a lot of snow, with the exception of this year. Summers can be around 30."*

**Deann on how we can help ...**

*"The best way churches can help to serve us while we are here is to pray for us. We have gone through a lot over the years, and going through it in another culture is not easy. Prayer has sustained us. We also have churches that partner with us financially, as well as prayerfully. We hope to increase our support base this coming year as we have lost some regular donors due to death, so if you are interested, we would love to have you partner with us."*

## MEET OUR NEW TEEN CHALLENGE STUDENT, SHAUN:

"Growing up, I witnessed alcohol abuse and physical abuse between my stepdad and my mom. When he left, we moved around a lot, living with relatives. This unsettled life didn't allow me to make friends. At 13, we finally settled in one place. Then I stole some cigarettes, was charged, and was given probation. My parents got back together, and we moved again. At 14, I had my first drink with my best friend and eventually tried marijuana and other drugs. I continued to drink alcohol and smoke cigarettes and marijuana into my 30's. I now had a one year old son with my fiancée, and I was starting my own business. I joined a pool league and began meeting new people. Numerous times, an individual offered me cocaine, until I accepted. What started as casual weekend use eventually consumed my life. I lost everything – my wife, kids, car, and money. I fell into deep addiction, lived on the streets, lost my job, and blew my last paycheque on crack cocaine. This was the end of the road for me. My mom and sister told me about Teen Challenge. At first, I thought one year was too long, but I realized that this one year could change my life. I decided to enter the program. Now my life is in God's hands. I have hope and a good future!"
