**Karen on what brought them to missions and to Rwanda ...**

"Colin and I felt a call to overseas service when we were young Christians at university. After over a decade of service in the difficult ministry of church planting in Belgium, we felt a call to minister among the poor in Africa."

**Karen on the best part of ministering in Rwanda ...**

"The best part of serving God in Rwanda is the weather – never too hot or too cold! We enjoy serving with our Christian brothers and sisters here in Rwanda and have a strong sense that we are making a difference here."

**Karen on the hardest part of ministering in Rwanda ...**

"The hardest part is the challenge to everyday living in a country that is still lacking in infrastructure – it can take an hour to get money out of the bank, and there are power outages almost every day."

"We miss drive through bank tellers and donuts. Most of all, we miss our family and friends."

**Karen on what life is like in Rwanda ...**

"Rwandans are hospitable and exuberant in their worship of God. They are enthusiastic about the role of the church in rebuilding the church after the 1994 genocide."

"Beans, rice, and stewed vegetables are the staple foods of Rwandans. Few people can afford to buy meat. Christians are challenged to witness to the goodness and grace of God amidst poverty and the brokenness of society after the genocide."
